

Getting Started With Your New TrucutCNC Machine

- (1) A complete operator manual can be downloaded on our website. Go to Support -> Downloads and select the manual for your machine. We recommend printing this manual.
- (2) The enclosed USB flash drive contains everything you need to reinstall Mach3 in the event of a PC crash. Keep it in a safe place. Also on the flash drive are some sample DXF files that you can cut. Samples can also be downloaded.
- (3) Prior to beginning setup of your machine, visit our website at www.trucutcnc.com and click on **Support -> Downloads**. Download the **Site Prep Guide**, the **Setup Guide** and the **Operator Manual for your machine**. The Site Prep Guide goes through what you will need to make the machine function, such as power and air requirements. Internet access to the machine is not required, but without it, tech support can be difficult. An internet connection allows us to remote to the machine for training and tech support. Additional tutorials can also be found on our website under **Support -> Tutorials**.
- (4) Once the site is prepared and the machine is grounded properly as per the instructions, refer to the Setup Guide, which will walk you through making your first cuts. Follow the guide step by step. If you can't get past a step, call us for assistance. If step 15 doesn't work, step 16 probably won't work either.
- (5) The machine includes a new Dell PC preloaded with Mach3 and SheetCAM. Also included in your package is a license for BobCAD. BobCAD can be downloaded from our website by going to **Support -> Downloads**. BobCAD V29 is the latest version. It is available in 64 bit only. Newer PC's are all 64 bit. BobCAD can be installed on the machine PC or in your office. We recommend installing it on an office PC. You can only install it on one PC. If the license for BobCAD, which will be a PDF file, is not in the Licenses folder on your USB flash drive, call and we will either upload it or email it to you. BobCAD licenses are not always here when the machine ships.
